WELCOME COCKTAIL RECEPTION

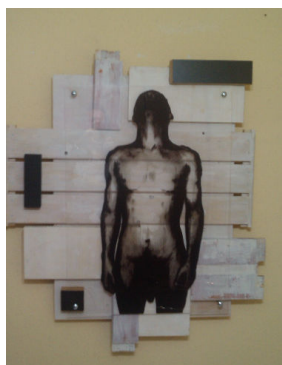
